ENTRANCE EXAM POLICIES

Dates:

Start Time:

All exams begin at 9:30am

Allowed Time:

Candidates are given 3 hours to complete the exam. Extra time may be granted to candidates providing documentation related to special circumstances.

Minimum Score:

Candidates must achieve a minimum score of 70% on the exam in order to meet this admission requirement. A successful score on this exam does not guarantee admission into the Advanced Standing Program. Admission is based on several other factors, including verification of prior learning and credentials from an Athletic Therapy Program in Ontario. (Specific exceptions may apply).

Results:

Candidates will be notified within 2 business days of an unsuccessful attempt. Students will be notified within a couple of weeks of a successful exam score, so that acceptance into the program can be confirmed. For the 2021 program intake, this exam is being used to verify your acceptance into the program. Credentials have been verified of each applicant to confirm suitability for the program. After the 2021 program intake, this exam will serve as a determining factor for eligibility for the program.

If you are not successful on your first attempt, you may attempt the exam again (up to a total of 3 times), by attending one of the remaining planned dates.

Electronic Devices:

You will be using Exam Professor to complete this exam. This is an electronic means of testing. Therefore you must bring a laptop or tablet with you. You may borrow an iPad if needed. The exam cannot be done on a cell phone. Any device being used must be muted, or in a "do not disturb" mode. Cell phones must be silent and not on vibrate mode, and must not be kept within reach during the exam.

Attendance and Punctuality:

You must arrive on time for your exam. You are encouraged to arrive by 9:15am at the latest. If you are late, you may not be permitted into the exam room, and may be required to wait until another room is set up for you. If arrival time is excessively late, you may be required to reschedule the exam for another of the set dates.

Upon arrival, you must check-in at the front desk. You will be instructed where to go from there.

Food and Drink:

During the exam, you may bring a beverage, but no food. If for some reason, you require food during the exam (ie, medical reason), you must let the proctor know prior to the start of the exam and make appropriate arrangements to leave the room and return.

Washrooms:

Washrooms are located on both floors of the school. One set is located in the main hall that you will enter after leaving reception, and the other is located immediately at the top of the stairs.

Covid-19 Protocols:

While in the building, all individuals are required to wear a mask at all times. While writing the exam, candidates will be appropriately distanced from other candidates.

Questions During the Exam:

If a candidate has a technical problem with the exam (Internet connection or other device technical issue), they may seek assistance from the exam proctor. The proctor cannot answer specific questions about the exam. Candidates may use a blank piece of paper to write an inquiry about a question to be left with the proctor for follow-up.

Academic Dishonesty:

To act dishonestly or unfairly to gain an advantage is not acceptable at the Ontario College of Health & Technology. Candidates who are caught cheating will receive a mark of zero and will not be permitted admission into the Advanced Standing Program.
